



We have been shortlisted for Tesco Bags of Help Your chance to help the club get funding

Haslingden Cricket Club have been put forward for the Tesco Bags of Help Grant Scheme and our project will be put forward to a customer vote in Tesco stores during January and February 2018.

What happens next?

Our project is the **HCC Pitch Drainage Improvement Project**, and along with the other two successful projects in our region it will go forward to a vote in Tesco stores where customers will decide the outcome by voting for their favourite project each time they shop.

Voting will take place from **Monday 1st January to Wednesday 28th February** and we will be notified by the end of March 2018 confirming the amount of funding we will receive.

The project with the highest number of votes across our region will receive a grant of up to £4,000, the second placed project up to £2,000 and the third placed project £1,000.

Tesco teamed up with Groundwork to launch its community funding scheme, which sees the grants – all raised from the 5p bag levy – being awarded to local community projects. Bags of Help offers community groups and projects across the UK a share of revenue generated from the 5p charge levied on single-use carrier bags.
